SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that any person who earned in the year preceding his or her application for a new license or a renewal up to twice the annual United States national poverty level as published in the Federal Register by the United States Department of Health and Human Services shall submit \$50 with the application for a new license and \$25 for a renewal. Provides that all fees collected under this provision shall be deposited into the State Police Firearm Services Fund. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by
5 changing Section 60 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

7 Sec. 60. Fees.

8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited as
9 provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and
10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.

11 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e), an An
12 applicant for a new license or a renewal shall submit \$150 with
13 the application, of which \$120 shall be apportioned to the
14 State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$20 shall be apportioned to
15 the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned
16 to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

17 (c) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e), a A
18 non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall
19 submit \$300 with the application, of which \$250 shall be
20 apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40
21 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and
22 \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

23 (d) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e), a A

1 licensee requesting a new license in accordance with Section 55
2 shall submit \$75, of which \$60 shall be apportioned to the
3 State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 shall be apportioned to
4 the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned
5 to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

6 (e) Any person who earned in the year preceding his or her
7 application for a new license or a renewal up to twice the
8 annual United States national poverty level as published in the
9 Federal Register by the United States Department of Health and
10 Human Services shall submit \$50 with the application for a new
11 license and \$25 for a renewal. All fees collected under this
12 subsection (e) shall be deposited into the State Police Firearm
13 Services Fund.
