1 AN ACT concerning education.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The College and Career Success for All Students

  Act is amended by adding Section 30 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 302/30 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 30. Examination; postsecondary-level course credit.</u>
- 8 (a) In this Section, "institution of higher education"
- 9 <u>means a public university or public community college located</u>
- in this State.
- 11 (b) Beginning with the 2016-2017 academic year, scores of
- 12 3, 4, and 5 on the College Board Advanced Placement
- examinations shall be accepted for credit to satisfy degree
- 14 requirements by all institutions of higher education. Each
- 15 institution of higher education shall determine for each test
- 16 whether credit will be granted for electives, general education
- 17 requirements, or major requirements and the Advanced Placement
- scores required to grant credit for those purposes.
- 19 (c) By the conclusion of the 2019-2020 academic year, the
- 20 Board of Higher Education, in cooperation with the Illinois
- 21 Community College Board, shall analyze the Advanced Placement
- 22 examination score course granting policy of each institution of
- 23 higher education and the research used by each institution in

- determining the level of credit and the number of credits
- 2 provided for the Advanced Placement scores in accordance with
- 3 the requirements of this Section and file a report that
- 4 includes findings and recommendations to the General Assembly
- 5 and the Governor. Each institution of higher education shall
- 6 provide the Board of Higher Education and the Illinois
- 7 Community College Board with all necessary data, in accordance
- 8 with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of
- 9 1974, to conduct the analysis.
- 10 (d) Each institution of higher education shall publish its
- 11 updated Advanced Placement examination score course granting
- 12 policy in accordance with the requirements of this Section on
- its Internet website before the beginning of the 2016-2017
- 14 academic year.
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
