1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Hospital Act is 5 amended by adding Section 8a as follows:

(110 ILCS 330/8a new)

7 Sec. 8a. Patient notice of observation status. Within 24 hours after a patient's placement into observation status by 8 9 the University of Illinois Hospital, the University of Illinois Hospital shall provide that patient with an oral and written 10 notice that the patient is not admitted to the hospital and is 11 12 under observation status. The written notice shall be signed by the patient or the patient's legal representative to 13 14 acknowledge receipt of the written notice and shall include, but not be limited to, the following information: 15

16 (1) a statement that observation status may affect 17 coverage under the federal Medicare program, the medical assistance program under Article V of the Illinois Public 18 19 Aid Code, or the patient's insurance policy for the current hospital services, including medications and other 20 21 pharmaceutical supplies, as well as coverage for any subsequent discharge to a skilled nursing facility or for 22 home and community based care; and 23

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1	(2) a statement that the patient should contact his or
2	her insurance provider to better understand the
3	implications of being placed into observation status.
4	Section 10. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by adding
5	Section 6.09b as follows:
6	(210 ILCS 85/6.09b new)
7	Sec. 6.09b. Patient notice of observation status. Within
8	24 hours after a patient's placement into observation status by
9	a hospital, the hospital shall provide that patient with an
10	oral and written notice that the patient is not admitted to the
11	hospital and is under observation status. The written notice
12	shall be signed by the patient or the patient's legal
13	representative to acknowledge receipt of the written notice and
14	shall include, but not be limited to, the following
15	information:
16	(1) a statement that observation status may affect
17	coverage under the federal Medicare program, the medical
18	assistance program under Article V of the Illinois Public
19	Aid Code, or the patient's insurance policy for the current
20	hospital services, including medications and other
21	pharmaceutical supplies, as well as coverage for any
22	subsequent discharge to a skilled nursing facility or for
23	home and community based care; and
24	(2) a statement that the patient should contact his or

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her insurance provider to better understand the implications of being placed into observation status.
