1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3763

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3763 by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those
7 amounts as may be necessary, are appropriated for General
8 State Aid to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
9 purposes as approximated below:

10	Payable from the Education Assistance Fund.....	401,223,700
11	Payable from the Common School Fund.....	3,611,012,300
12	Payable from the General Revenue Fund.....	173,952,200
13	Payable from the Fund for the Advancement	
14	of Education:	446,000,000

1 Section 10. The amount of \$85,000,000 is appropriated
 2 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of
 3 Education to provide a supplemental grant to entities that
 4 receive General State Aid to limit the loss per student due
 5 to the difference between the General State Aid claim as
 6 calculated pursuant to Section 18-8.05 and the amount
 7 appropriated for purposes of Section 18-8.05 divided by the
 8 Average Daily Attendance as defined in subsection (C)(2) of
 9 Section 18-8.05. This supplemental grant shall be paid first
 10 to the entity with the greatest loss per student, and then to
 11 the next entity with the greatest loss per student until
 12 losses per student are reduced to their smallest possible
 13 amount given this appropriation.

14 Section 15. The following amounts or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State
 16 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and
 17 not, under any circumstances, for personal services
 18 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,
 19 are appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for
 20 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015:

12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
14 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Southwest Organizing
15 Project Parent Mentoring Program.

17 Section 5. The following amounts or so much thereof as

 2 appropriated for such purposes, the following named amounts,
 3 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from
 4 the SBE Federal Department of Education Fund, pursuant to the
 5 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, to the
 6 Illinois State Board of Education for the fiscal year
 7 beginning July 1, 2015:

10 Section 20. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof
 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School
 12 Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education
 13 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

14 Section 25. The amount of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof
 15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Temporary
 16 Relocation Expenses Revolving Grant Fund for use by the State
 17 Board of Education as provided in Section 2-3.77 of the
 18 School Code.

19 Section 30. The amount of \$2,208,900, or so much thereof
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE Teacher
 21 Certificate Institute Fund to the Illinois State Board of

1 Education for Teacher Certificates.

2 Section 35. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Teacher
4 Certificate Fee Revolving Fund to the Illinois State Board of
5 Education for Teacher Mentoring Programs.

6 Section 40. The amount of \$8,484,800, or so much of that
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State
8 Board of Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the State
9 Board of Education for expenditures by the Board in
10 accordance with grants, gifts or donations that the Board has
11 received or may receive from any source, public or private,
12 in support of projects that are within the lawful powers of
13 the Board.

14 Section 45. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of that
15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the After-
16 School Rescue Fund to the State Board of Education for its
17 ordinary and contingent expenses.

18 Section 50. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal
20 Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State Board of
21 Education for all costs associated with related activities

1 for the Early Learning Challenge for the fiscal year
2 beginning July 1, 2015.

3 ARTICLE 3

4 Section 5. The sum of \$3,741,702,194, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
6 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of
7 Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

8 Section 10. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
10 Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the
11 State of Illinois for additional costs due to the
12 establishment of minimum retirement allowances pursuant to
13 Sections 16-136.2 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code,
14 as amended.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund
17 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer
18 contributions required by the State as an employer of
19 teachers described under subsection (e) of Section 16-158 of
20 the Illinois Pension Code.

1 Section 20. The amount of \$12,105,000, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
3 Revenue Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and
4 Retirement Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for
5 retirement contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois
6 Pension Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015.

7 Section 25. The amount of \$108,258,261, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
9 Education Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System
10 of the State of Illinois for deposit into the Teacher Health
11 Insurance Security Fund as the state's contribution for
12 teachers' health insurance.

13 Section 30. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund
15 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer
16 contributions required by the State as an employer of
17 teachers described under subsection (f) of Section 16-158 of
18 the Illinois Pension Code.

20 ARTICLE 999

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July

1 1, 2015.".
