SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806 625 ILCS 5/3-806.10 new from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the initial standard registration fee shall not be required for persons changing registration of a vehicle following the death of a spouse, if that vehicle was owned by the deceased spouse. Makes conforming changes. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

Section 3-806 and by adding Section 3-806.10 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806)

Sec. 3-806. Registration Fees; Motor Vehicles of the First Division. Every owner of any other motor vehicle of the first division, except as provided in Sections 3-804, 3-804.01, 3-804.3, 3-805, 3-806.3, 3-806.7, 3-806.10, and 3-808, and every second division vehicle weighing 8,000 pounds or less, shall pay the Secretary of State an annual registration fee at the following rates:

- A \$1 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above
- 5 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles,

- 8 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by
- 9 Public Act 96-34 shall be deposited into the Capital Projects

- 25 Beginning with the 2016 registration year, the initial

- 1 standard registration fee set forth in Section 3-806 of this 2 Code for passenger motor vehicles of the first division and 3 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds and registered under Section 3-815 of this Code 4 5 shall not be required for persons changing registration of a 6 vehicle following the death of a spouse, if that vehicle was owned by the deceased spouse.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 8 9 becoming law.
