## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.1

from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that a home rule county may not regulate, license, restrict the possession of, or require registration for, firearms and firearm ammunition. Provides that a home rule county may not regulate the transportation of firearms or firearm ammunition. Provides that these are exclusive powers and functions of the State. Provides that any ordinance or regulation, or portion thereof, enacted on, before, or after the effective date of the amendatory Act that purports to impose regulations or restrictions on firearms or firearm ammunition in any manner is invalid on the effective date of the amendatory Act. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning safety.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is 5 amended by changing Section 13.1 as follows:
- (430 ILCS 65/13.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1) 6
- 7 Sec. 13.1. Preemption.

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- (a) Except as otherwise provided in the Firearm Concealed 8 9 Carry Act and subsections (b) and (c) of this Section, the provisions of any ordinance enacted by any municipality which 10 requires registration or imposes greater restrictions or 11 limitations on the acquisition, possession and transfer of 12 firearms than are imposed by this Act, are not invalidated or 13 14 affected by this Act.
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this Section, the regulation, licensing, possession, and registration handguns and ammunition for a handgun, and the transportation of any firearm and ammunition by a holder of a valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card issued by the Department of State Police under this Act are exclusive powers and functions of this State. Any ordinance or regulation, or portion of that ordinance or regulation, enacted on or before the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly that 23

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purports to impose regulations or restrictions on a holder of a valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card issued by the Department of State Police under this Act in a manner that is inconsistent with this Act, on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, shall be invalid in its application to a holder of a valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card issued by the Department of State Police under this Act.

(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this Section, the regulation of the possession or ownership of assault weapons are exclusive powers and functions of this State. Any ordinance or regulation, or portion of that ordinance or regulation, that purports to regulate the possession or ownership of assault weapons in a manner that is inconsistent with this Act, shall be invalid unless the ordinance or regulation is enacted on, before, or within 10 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly. Any ordinance or regulation described in this subsection (c) enacted more than 10 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly is invalid. An ordinance enacted on, before, or within 10 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly may be amended. The enactment or amendment of ordinances under this subsection (c) are subject to the submission requirements of Section 13.3. For the purposes of this subsection, "assault weapons" means firearms designated by either make or model or by a test or

- 1 list of cosmetic features that cumulatively would place the
- 2 firearm into a definition of "assault weapon" under the
- 3 ordinance.
- 4 (c-5) A home rule county may not regulate, license,
- 5 restrict the possession of, or require registration for,
- 6 firearms and firearm ammunition. A home rule county may not
- 7 regulate the transportation of firearms or firearm ammunition.
- 8 These are exclusive powers and functions of the State. Any
- 9 ordinance or regulation, or portion thereof, enacted on,
- 10 before, or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of
- 11 the 99th General Assembly that purports to impose regulations
- or restrictions on firearms or firearm ammunition in any manner
- is invalid on the effective date of this amendatory Act.
- 14 (d) For the purposes of this Section, "handgun" has the
- 15 meaning ascribed to it in Section 5 of the Firearm Concealed
- 16 Carry Act.
- 17 (e) This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule
- 18 powers and functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of
- 19 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
