## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Governmental Ethics Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 3A-5 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 3A-5. Definitions. As used in this Article:
- 8 "Late term appointee" means a person who is appointed to an
- 9 office: (1) by a Governor who does not succeed himself or
- 10 herself as Governor, whose appointment requires the advice and
- 11 consent of the Senate, and whose appointment is confirmed by
- 12 the Senate 90 or fewer days before the end of the appointing
- Governor's term; or (2) by a board or other body having one or
- more members appointed by the Governor, when the Governor does
- not succeed himself or herself as Governor, and the effective
- date of the appointment is 90 or fewer days before the end of
- the appointing Governor's term. Item (2) does not apply to a
- board or other body to which the Attorney General, Secretary of
- 19 State, Comptroller, or Treasurer also appoints one or more
- members.
- 21 "Succeeding Governor" means the Governor in office
- 22 immediately after a Governor who appoints a late term
- 23 appointee.
