#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-682

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the use of funds in the Illinois Police Association Fund from sale of Illinois Police Association license plates to be allocated as follows: at least 10% for providing death benefits for the families of police officers killed in the line of duty; at least 10% for providing scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty; and the remainder for operational costs of the Illinois Police Association. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing  
5 Section 3-682 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-682)

7 Sec. 3-682. Illinois Police Association license plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in  
9 the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special  
10 registration plates designated as Illinois Police Association  
11 license plates. The special plates issued under this Section  
12 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first  
13 division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not  
14 more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall  
15 expire according to the multi-year procedure established by  
16 Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

17 (b) The design and color of the plates is wholly within the  
18 discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary may allow the plates  
19 to be issued as vanity plates or personalized under Section  
20 3-405.1 of the Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or  
21 decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code. The  
22 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be  
23 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with

1 Section 3-405.1 of this Code.

2 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a  
3 \$25 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate  
4 registration fee. Of this fee, \$10 shall be deposited into the  
5 Illinois Police Association Fund and \$15 shall be deposited  
6 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be  
7 used by the Secretary to help defray the administrative  
8 processing costs.

9 For each registration renewal period, a \$25 fee, in  
10 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.  
11 Of this fee, \$23 shall be deposited into the Illinois Police  
12 Association Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary  
13 of State Special License Plate Fund.

14 (d) The Illinois Police Association Fund is created as a  
15 special fund in the State treasury. All money in the Illinois  
16 Police Association Fund shall be used, subject to  
17 appropriation, as follows: at least 10% for providing death  
18 benefits for the families of police officers killed in the line  
19 of duty; at least 10% ~~, and~~ for providing scholarships, for  
20 graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children and  
21 spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty; and the  
22 remainder for operational costs of the Illinois Police  
23 Association. The changes made by this amendatory Act of the  
24 99th General Assembly apply to money in the fund on and after  
25 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General  
26 Assembly.
