1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4147

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4147 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
10 June 30, 2016:

8 Section 10. The sum of \$83,800, or so much thereof as may

12 with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$193,500, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
16 with MyCreditsTransfer.

17 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
19 Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for
20 distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education

13 Section 30. The sum of \$1,034,900, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 15 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as

 17 higher education.

18 Section 35. The sum of \$1,114,400, or so much thereof as
 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 20 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the
 21 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for
 22 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

1 Section 40. The sum of \$1,383,700, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration
4 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying
5 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

6 Section 45. The sum of \$1,466,300, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the Grow
9 Your Own Teachers Program.

10 Section 50. The sum of \$394,600, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants
13 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating
14 nurses.

15 Section 55. The sum of \$208,300, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator
18 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

19 Section 60. The sum of \$93,000, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

1 to the Board of Higher Education for the Washington Center
2 Intern Program.

3 Section 65. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality
5 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as
6 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with
7 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

8 Section 70. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College
10 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher
11 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
12 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110
13 ILCS 1005.

14 Section 75. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business
16 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
17 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and
18 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement
19 of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

20 Section 80. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants

1 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under
 2 the terms and conditions associated with the federal
 3 contracts and grants moneys received.

4 Section 85. The following named amounts, or so much
 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
 7 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and
 8 Science Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for
 9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016:

1 Section 5. The sum of \$185,426,500 or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education
3 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
4 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
5 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

7 Section 10. The sum of \$1,173,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
9 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
10 University for all costs associated with the SimmonsCooper
11 Cancer Center.

12 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
14 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern
15 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
16 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
19 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
20 Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with
21 the development, support or administration of pharmacy
22 practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville

1 campus.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$64,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Southern Illinois University for any costs
5 associated with the Daily Egyptian newspaper.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$311,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
8 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University
9 for costs associated with fire protection services at the
10 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville campus.

11 ARTICLE 3

12 Section 1. The sum of \$545,127,300 or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education
14 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of University of
15 Illinois for ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 2016.

17 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
19 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
20 of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet

1 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
2 June 30, 2016:

9 Section 10. The sum of \$15,378,800, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
12 for costs and expenses related to or in support of the
13 Prairie Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-
14 0728.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$41,128,300, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
18 for operating costs and expenses related to or in support of
19 the University of Illinois Hospital.

20 Section 20. The sum of \$686,300, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
22 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of

1 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for
2 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

3 Section 25. The sum of \$281,700, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
5 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
6 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$1,072,300, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
9 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
10 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy
11 Institute at the Chicago campus.

12 Section 35. The sum of \$300,200, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
14 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
15 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

16 Section 40. The sum of \$3,816,200, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
18 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
19 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
20 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
21 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment

1 to the University for personal services and related costs
2 incurred.

3 Section 45. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
5 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
6 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
7 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

8 Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
10 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
11 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
12 Abatement.

13 Section 55. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
15 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
16 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
17 abatement.

18 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
20 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
21 and contingent expenses.

1 Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
3 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
4 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
5 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
6 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
7 Rockford.

8 ARTICLE 999

9 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
10 1, 2015.".
