

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$33,512,100, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education  
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State  
8 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State  
12 University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of  
13 Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses  
14 incurred by the university.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
17 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
18 Chicago State University for costs associated with the  
19 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice  
20 education or training programs.

1           Section 20. The sum of \$488,800, or so much thereof as  
2       may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
3       Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State  
4       University as a grant to the Financial Assistance Outreach  
5       Center.

6   ARTICLE 2

7           Section 5. The sum of \$22,498,000, or so much thereof as  
8       may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
9       Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Governors State  
10      University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
11      fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.
