11 Section 5. The sum of \$48,101,300, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education 13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois 14 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the 15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

16 Section 10. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and 18 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western 19 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the 20 sale of collegiate license plates.
