

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$4,969,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Office of the Governor for operational expenses  
8 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Governor's Grant  
11 Fund to the Office of the Governor to be expended in  
12 accordance with the terms and conditions upon which such  
13 funds were received and in the exercise of the powers or  
14 performance of the duties of the Office of the Governor.

15 ARTICLE 2

16 Section 5. The amount of \$1,256,400, or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
18 Fund to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor to meet its  
19 operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1,

1 2015.

2 Section 10. The sum of \$47,500, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Agricultural  
4 Premium Fund to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor for all  
5 costs associated with the Rural Affairs Council including any  
6 grants or administrative expenses.

7 ARTICLE 3

8 Section 5. The sum of \$30,843,200, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
10 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to meet its  
11 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
12 2016.

13 Section 10. The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement  
16 to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation for use as provided  
17 in the Illinois Equal Justice Act.

18 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
19 is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated  
20 to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law

1 Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

2 Section 20. The sum of \$11,200,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
4 General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment  
5 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,  
6 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the  
7 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the  
8 duties of the Attorney General, including State law  
9 enforcement and public education.

10 Section 25. The sum of \$1,900,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Charity  
12 Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to enforce  
13 the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act and to  
14 gather and disseminate information about charitable trustees  
15 and organizations to the public.

16 Section 30. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General  
18 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Office of the  
19 Attorney General for ordinary and contingent expenses,  
20 including State law enforcement purposes.

21 Section 35. The sum of \$11,300,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
 2 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund  
 3 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency  
 4 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,  
 5 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any  
 6 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the  
 7 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public  
 8 education.

9 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
 11 purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the  
 12 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses  
 13 of the Attorney General:

4 Section 45. The sum of \$240,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support  
6 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for  
7 child support enforcement purposes.

8 Section 50. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General  
10 Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for  
11 funding for federal grants.

12 Section 55. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the  
14 Attorney General from the Domestic Violence Fund pursuant to  
15 Public Act 95-711 for grants to public or private nonprofit  
16 agencies for the purposes of facilitating or providing free  
17 domestic violence legal advocacy, assistance, or services to  
18 victims of domestic violence who are married or formerly  
19 married or parties or former parties to a civil union related  
20 to order of protection proceedings, or other proceedings for  
21 civil remedies for domestic violence.

1           Section 60. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General  
3           Tobacco Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for the  
4           oversight, enforcement, and implementation of the Master  
5           Settlement Agreement entered in the case of People of the  
6           State of Illinois v. Philip Morris, et al (Circuit Court of  
7           Cook County, No. 96L13146), for the administration and  
8           enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,  
9           for the handling of tobacco-related litigation, and for other  
10          law enforcement activities of the Attorney General.

11          Section 65. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may  
12          be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General Sex  
13          Offender Awareness, Training, and Education Fund to the  
14          Office of the Attorney General to administer the I-SORT  
15          program and to alert and educate the public, victims, and  
16          witnesses of their rights under various victim notification  
17          laws and for training law enforcement agencies, State's  
18          Attorneys, and medical providers regarding their legal duties  
19          concerning the prosecution and investigation of sex offenses.

5 ARTICLE 8

6 Section 5. The sum of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the  
8 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
9 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section  
10 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of  
11 their respective houses throughout the year in connection  
12 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in  
13 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law.  
14 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of  
15 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated  
16 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

17 Section 10. Payments from the sums appropriated in  
18 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a  
19 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The  
20 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate  
21 or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case  
22 may be.

1           Section 15. The sum of \$20,603,400, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet  
3 the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate  
4 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and  
5 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general  
6 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% is  
7 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such  
8 expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority  
9 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the  
10 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is  
11 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such  
12 expenditures.

13           Section 20. The sum of \$9,882,100, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the  
15 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
16 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of  
17 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem  
18 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred  
19 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount,  
20 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for  
21 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker  
22 of the House for such expenditures.

1           Section 25. The sum of \$309,200, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the  
3           President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
4           Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses,  
5           also including the purchasing on contract as required by law  
6           of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office  
7           supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended  
8           for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such  
9           supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred  
10          without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of  
11          Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to  
12          the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723%  
13          is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such  
14          expenditures.

15          Section 30. The sum of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as  
16          may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the  
17          President of the Senate for the use of standing committees  
18          for expert witnesses, technical services, consulting  
19          assistance and other research assistance associated with
