1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 Section 5. "AN ACT making appropriations", Public Act 98-5 0680, approved June 30, 2014, is amended by changing Section 6 7 10 of Article 9 as follows: (P.A. 98-0680, Art. 9, Sec. 10) 8 9 Sec. 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to 11 the 12 Department of Human Services for income assistance related distributive purposes, including such Federal funds 13 14 as are made available by the Federal Government for the 15 following purposes: 16 DISTRIBUTIVE ITEMS 17 GRANTS-IN-AID Payable from General Revenue Fund: 18 19 For Aid to Aged, Blind or Disabled 20
