Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Requires any insurer offering certain types of insurance to offer fidelity bonds to any individual, regardless of any record of arrest, conviction, or imprisonment, upon request.

Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding
Section 143.35 as follows:

 7 Sec. 143.35. Fidelity bonds for individuals. Any insurer
 8 offering Class 2 insurance as described in Section 4 of this
 9 Code shall offer fidelity bonds to any individual, regardless
 10 of any record of arrest, conviction, or imprisonment, upon
 11 request.
