1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4305

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4305 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
5 as are available for distribution in accordance with Section 8  
6 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor Fuel  
7 Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the purposes  
8 stated:

9 DISTRIBUTIVE ITEMS

10 For apportioning, allotting, and paying  
11 as provided by law:

12	To Counties.....	204,108,000
13	To Municipalities.....	285,775,000
14	To Counties for Distribution to	
15	Road Districts.....	<u>92,617,000</u>

1           Total   \$582,500,000

2           Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund  
4 to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local  
5 governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior  
6 year costs.

7           Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery  
9 Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to  
10 holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes  
11 related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of  
12 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of  
13 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois  
14 Lottery Law.

15          Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
17 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service  
18 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911  
19 Administrator Program.

20          Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1

1 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to  
2 the Emergency Telephone System Act.

3 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service  
5 Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its  
6 administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone  
7 system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department  
8 of State Police for the design, implementation, operation,  
9 maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency  
10 services and public safety answering points.

11 Section 35. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
13 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
14 contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

15 GOVERNMENT SERVICES

16 PAYABLE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT VIDEO GAMING

17 DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

18 For allocation to local governments  
19 of the net terminal income tax per  
20 the Video Gaming Act.....45,000,000

21 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
22 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of

1 Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:

2 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROMOTION

3 Payable from the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund:

4 For grants to conduct Multiple

5 Sclerosis research.....3,000,000

6 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of  
8 Public Health for expenses of programs related to Acquired  
9 Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and Human Immunodeficiency  
10 Virus (HIV):

11 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROTECTION: AIDS/HIV

12 Payable from the Quality of Life Endowment Fund:

13 For grants and expenses associated

14 with HIV/AIDS prevention and education.....2,000,000

15 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department  
17 of Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter  
18 named:

19 OFFICE OF WOMEN'S HEALTH

20 Payable from the Carolyn Adams Ticket

21 for the Cure Grant Fund:

22 For Grants and related expenses to

23 public or private entities in Illinois

1 for the purpose of funding research  
 2 concerning breast cancer and for  
 3 funding services for breast cancer victims.....2,500,000

4 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 5 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter  
 6 named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for  
 7 Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions  
 8 pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and  
 9 the Community Mental Health Act:

10 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

11 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

12 Payable from Special Olympics Illinois and  
 13 Special Children's Charities Fund:

14 For grants to Special Olympics

15 Illinois and Special Children's Charities.....700,000

16 Section 60. The sum of \$8,300,000, or so much thereof as  
 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans  
 18 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for  
 19 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting  
 20 additional research projects relating to veterans' post  
 21 traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health  
 22 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits,  
 23 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by

1 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance  
2 commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans.

3 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
5 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the IMSA  
6 Income Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to  
7 meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year  
8 ending June 30, 2016:

9	For Personal Services.....	2,261,900
10	For State Contributions to Social	
11	Security, for Medicare.....	45,900
12	For Contractual Services.....	294,700
13	For Travel.....	126,700
14	For Commodities.....	143,200
15	For Equipment.....	65,000

21 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this  
22 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through June  
23 30, 2016.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
2    becoming law.”.
