- AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4305, by replacing 2 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: 4 "Section 5. - 21 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through June
- 22 30, 2016.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 1
- 2 becoming law.".
