1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4305

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4305, by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6 as are available for distribution in accordance with Section 8
7 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor Fuel
8 Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the purposes
9 stated:

10 DISTRIBUTIVE ITEMS

11 For apportioning, allotting, and paying
12 as provided by law:

13	To Counties.....	204,108,000
14	To Municipalities.....	285,775,000

1	To Counties for Distribution to	
2	Road Districts.....	<u>92,617,000</u>
3	Total	\$582,500,000

4 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund
6 to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local
7 governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior
8 year costs.

9 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery
11 Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to
12 holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes
13 related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of
14 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of
15 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois
16 Lottery Law.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
19 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service
20 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911
21 Administrator Program.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1
 3 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to
 4 the Emergency Telephone System Act.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof
 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service
 7 Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its
 8 administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone
 9 system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department
 10 of State Police for the design, implementation, operation,
 11 maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency
 12 services and public safety answering points.

13 Section 35. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 14 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
 15 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
 16 contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

17 GOVERNMENT SERVICES

18 PAYABLE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT VIDEO GAMING

19 DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

20 For allocation to local governments

21 of the net terminal income tax per

22 the Video Gaming Act.....45,000,000

7 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 8 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of
 9 Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:

10 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROMOTION

11 Payable from the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund:

12 For grants to conduct Multiple
 13 Sclerosis research.....3,000,000

14 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 15 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of
 16 Public Health for expenses of programs related to Acquired
 17 Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and Human Immunodeficiency
 18 Virus (HIV):

19 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROTECTION: AIDS/HIV

20 Payable from the Quality of Life Endowment Fund:

21 For grants and expenses associated
 22 with HIV/AIDS prevention and education.....2,000,000

1 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department
3 of Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter
4 named:

5 OFFICE OF WOMEN'S HEALTH

6 Payable from the Carolyn Adams Ticket
7 for the Cure Grant Fund:

8 For Grants and related expenses to
9 public or private entities in Illinois
10 for the purpose of funding research
11 concerning breast cancer and for
12 funding services for breast cancer victims.....2,500,000

13 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter
15 named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for
16 Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions
17 pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and
18 the Community Mental Health Act:

19 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

20 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

21 Payable from Special Olympics Illinois and
22 Special Children's Charities Fund:

23 For grants to Special Olympics
24 Illinois and Special Children's Charities.....700,000

1 Section 60. The sum of \$8,300,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans
 3 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for
 4 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting
 5 additional research projects relating to veterans' post
 6 traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health
 7 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits,
 8 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by
 9 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance
 10 commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans.

11 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much
 12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
 13 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the IMSA
 14 Income Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to
 15 meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year
 16 ending June 30, 2016:

6 Section 70. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for
8 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State
9 Fire Marshal, as follows:

10 GRANTS

11 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

12	For Chicago Fire Department Training Program.....	2,544,200
13	For payment to local governmental agencies	
14	which participate in the State Training	
15	Programs.....	<u>950,000</u>
16	Total	\$3,494,200

17 Section 75. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
19 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
20 for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS administration.

21 Section 80. The sum of \$3,816,200, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund

1 to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the
2 purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service Institute,
3 paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the facilities
4 and structures incident thereto, including payment to the
5 University for personal services and related costs incurred.

6 ARTICLE 998

7 Section 5. The appropriation authority granted in this
8 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through June
9 30, 2016.

10 ARTICLE 999

11 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
12 becoming law.”.
