1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4334
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 4334 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4 5	"Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 3-821.2 as follows:
6	(625 ILCS 5/3-821.2)
7	Sec. 3-821.2. Delinquent registration renewal fee.
8	<u>(a)</u> For registration renewal periods beginning on or after
9	January 1, 2005, the Secretary of State may impose a delinquent
10	registration renewal fee of \$20 for the registration renewal of
11	all passenger vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles
12	of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds if
13	the application for registration renewal is received by the
14	Secretary more than one month after the expiration of the most
15	recent period during which the vehicle was registered. If a
16	delinquent registration renewal fee is imposed, the Secretary

1 shall not renew the registration of such a vehicle until the 2 delinquent registration renewal fee has been paid, in addition to any other registration fees owed for the vehicle. Active 3 4 duty military personnel stationed outside of Illinois shall not 5 be required to pay the delinquent registration renewal fee. If 6 a delinguent registration renewal fee is imposed, the Secretary shall adopt rules for the implementation of this Section. All 7 fees collected under this Section shall be deposited into the 8 9 General Revenue Fund.

10 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), the 11 Secretary of State shall not impose a delinquent registration renewal fee for the registration renewal of all passenger 12 13 vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second 14 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds if a vehicle's 15 registration expires during a period of time in which no notice, by U.S. mail, was sent to the vehicle owner by the 16 Secretary. Any local, county, municipal, or state law 17 enforcement agency may not issue a citation for an expired 18 19 registration until one month after the expiration of the 20 registration under this subsection (b). If the Secretary resumes mailing registration renewal notices, then the 21 22 Secretary may resume the collection of the delinquent registration renewal fee under subsection (a), and any local, 23 24 county, municipal, or state law enforcement agency may resume 25 citing any vehicle with an expired registration without waiting the one month period required by this subsection (b).
