## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 460/40

from Ch. 1, par. 2901-40

Amends the State Designations Act. Provides that the Kankakee Mallow is designated the native State flower (currently, the native violet). Effective immediately.

- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The State Designations Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 40 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 460/40) (from Ch. 1, par. 2901-40)
- Sec. 40. State tree and flower. The white oak tree is
- 8 designated the native State tree of the State of Illinois; and
- 9 the Kankakee mallow native violet is designated the native
- 10 State flower of the State of Illinois.

- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
