1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4477 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4477, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 3 4 following: "Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by 5 6 adding Section 30-50 as follows: 7 (30 ILCS 500/30-50 new) 8 Sec. 30-50. Mobilization payments. (a) As used in this Section, "mobilization payment" means 9 10 an advance payment to a contractor or subcontractor that enables the contractor or subcontractor to purchase necessary 11 machinery and tools for a project. "Mobilization payment" may 12 13 also include other goods or services necessary for a project 14 when expressly provided for within the contract. 15 (b) All contracts under this Code entered into by the Department of Transportation shall provide for mobilization 16

1	payments unless explicitly rejected by the contractor.	
2	(c) When a contract unde	r this Code entered into by the
3	Department of Transportati	on provides for mobilization
4	payments and the contractor	s is using the services of a
5	subcontractor, the subcontrac	ct shall include terms requiring
6	mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor.	
7	Mobilization payments to a subcontractor shall be made on a	
8	tiered system based on the total value of the subcontract:	
9	Subcontract value	Mobilization percentage
10	Less than \$10,000	<u>25%</u>
11	\$10,000-\$19,999	20%
12	\$20,000-\$39,999	<u>18%</u>
13	\$40,000-\$59,999	<u>16%</u>
14	\$60,000-\$79,999	<u>14%</u>
15	<u>\$80,000-\$99,999</u>	<u>12%</u>
16	\$100,000-\$249,999	<u>10%</u>
17	<u>\$250,000-\$499,999</u>	9%
18	<u>\$500,000-\$750,000</u>	<u>8%</u>
19	<u>Over \$750,000</u>	<u>7%</u>
