Makes various appropriations concerning higher education and the Illinois Math and Science Academy, if and only if House Bill 4521 of the 99th General Assembly becomes law. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. As used in this Act, "operational expenses" 5 6 includes the following: personal services; State 7 contributions to social security; State contributions to group insurance; contractual services; travel; commodities; 8 9 equipment; electronic data processing; 10 telecommunications services; operation of equipment; refunds; employee retirement contributions paid by 11 12 the employer; permanent improvements; and deposits to other funds. 13

Section 25. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

Section 30. The sum of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of the Higher Education Distance Learning Act.

Section 5. The amount of \$29,519,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education

- 11 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this
- 12 Act shall be valid only for costs incurred July 1, 2015
- 13 through June 30, 2016.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law, but this Act does not take effect at all unless
- House Bill 4521 of the 99th General Assembly, as introduced in
- 17 the House of Representatives, becomes law.
