- 10 (r), (t), (w), and (y) of Section 2.33, and the administrative
- 11 rules issued under the provisions of those Sections. It is
- 12 unlawful for any person to knowingly take any all-white
- 13 whitetail deer (Odocoileus virginianus) in this State at any
- 14 time.
