SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 805/2-16.06
110 ILCS 805/2-16.07

Amends the Public Community College Act. Provides that the ICCB Adult Education Fund and the Career and Technical Education Fund are federal funds (instead of special funds) in the State treasury. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Public Community College Act is amended by
5 changing Sections 2-16.06 and 2-16.07 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 805/2-16.06)

7 Sec. 2-16.06. ICCB Adult Education Fund. The ICCB Adult
8 Education Fund is created as a federal ~~special~~ fund in the
9 State treasury. All money in the ICCB Adult Education Fund may
10 be used, subject to appropriation, by the State Board for
11 operational expenses associated with the administration of
12 adult education and literacy activities and for the payment of
13 costs associated with education and educational-related
14 services to local eligible providers for adult education and
15 literacy as provided by the United States Department of
16 Education.

19 Sec. 2-16.07. Career and Technical Education Fund. The
20 Career and Technical Education Fund is created as a federal
21 ~~special~~ fund in the State treasury. The Comptroller shall order
22 transferred and the State Treasurer shall transfer from the

1 Federal Department of Education Fund into the Career and
2 Technical Education Fund such amounts as may be directed in
3 writing by the State Board of Education. All moneys so
4 deposited into the Career and Technical Education Fund may be
5 used, subject to appropriation, by the State Board for
6 operational expenses associated with the administration of
7 Career and Technical Education, for payment of Career and
8 Technical Education grants to colleges, and for payment of
9 costs relating to State leadership activities, as provided by
10 the United States Department of Education.
