Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning unlawful practices.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 262)
- 7 Sec. 2.
- Unfair methods of competition and and unfair or deceptive 8 9 acts or practices, including but not limited to the use or employment of any deception fraud, false pretense, false 10 promise, misrepresentation or the concealment, suppression or 11 12 omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely 13 upon the concealment, suppression or omission of such material 14 fact, or the use or employment of any practice described in Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act", 15 approved August 5, 1965, in the conduct of any trade or 16 17 commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether any person has in fact been misled, deceived or damaged thereby. In construing 18 19 section consideration shall be given 20 interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal

courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the Federal Trade

22 Commission Act.
