A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of
8 Human Services for Family and Community Services and related
9 distributive purposes:

10 FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES GRANTS-IN-AID

11 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

12 For Homeless Prevention1,000,000

13 For Grants and Administrative Expenses

14 for Homeless Youth Services4,598,100

15 For Grants and Administrative Expenses

16 of Supportive Housing Services13,738,500

17 Payable from the Illinois Affordable Housing

18 Trust Fund:

19 For Homeless Youth Services1,000,000

20 For Grants and Administrative Expenses

21 for Homelessness Prevention3,000,000

22 For Grants and Administrative Expenses

1 for Emergency and Transitional Housing9,383,700
 2 Payable from the Health and Human
 3 Service Medicaid Trust Fund:
 4 For grants for Supportive Housing Services3,382,500

 8 Administrative Costs and Grants300,000

9 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes
 11 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of
 12 Human Services for Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its
 13 various regions pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community
 14 Services Act and the Community Mental Health Act:

15 MENTAL HEALTH GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

16 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

17 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:
 18 For Supportive MI Housing15,915,800

19 Section 15. The sum of \$34,450,000, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Human
 21 Services from the Health and Human Services Medicaid Trust
 22 Fund for awards and grants to developmental disabilities
 23 and/or mental health programs.

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ARTICLE 2

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Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

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PAYABLE FROM RENTAL HOUSING SUPPORT PROGRAM FUND

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For administration of the Rental

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Housing Support Program1,600,000

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PAYABLE FROM ILLINOIS AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND

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For administration of the Illinois

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Affordable Housing Act4,100,000

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Section 10. The sum of \$65,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for grants, (down payment assistance, rental subsidies, security deposit subsidies, technical assistance, outreach, building an organization's capacity to develop affordable housing projects and other related purposes), mortgages, loans, or for the purpose of securing bonds pursuant to the Illinois Affordable Housing Act, administered by the Illinois Housing Development Authority.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
3 Affordable Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue
4 for grants to other state agencies for rental assistance,
5 supportive living and adaptive housing.

6 Section 20. The sum of \$25,000,000, new appropriation,
7 is appropriated and the sum of \$15,000,000, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the
9 close of business on June 30, 2015, from appropriations and
10 reappropriations heretofore made in Article 35, Section 30 of
11 Public Act 98-0679 is reappropriated from the Federal HOME
12 Investment Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for the
13 Illinois HOME Investment Partnerships Program administered by
14 the Illinois Housing Development Authority.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$8,500,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure
17 Prevention Program Fund to the Department of Revenue for
18 administration by the Illinois Housing Development Authority,
19 for grants and administrative expenses pursuant to the
20 Foreclosure Prevention Program.

21 Section 30. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure
2 Prevention Program Graduated Fund to the Department of
3 Revenue for administration by the Illinois Housing
4 Development Authority, for grants and administrative expenses
5 pursuant to the Foreclosure Prevention Program.

6 Section 35. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Abandoned
8 Residential Property Municipality Relief Fund to the
9 Department of Revenue for administration by the Illinois
10 Housing Development Authority, for grants and administrative
11 expenses pursuant to the Abandoned Residential Property
12 Municipality Relief Program.

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14 Section 40. The sum of \$25,000,000, new appropriation, is
15 appropriated and the sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of
17 business on June 30, 2015, from appropriations heretofore
18 made in Article 35, Section 5 of Public Act 98-0064 is
19 reappropriated from the Rental Housing Support Program Fund
20 to the Department of Revenue for current and prior year costs
21 of the Rental Housing Support Program administered by the
22 Illinois Housing Development Authority.

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ARTICLE 998

1 Section 998. The appropriation authority granted in this
2 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
3 June 30, 2016.

4 ARTICLE 999

5 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
6 becoming law.
