1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5402

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 5402 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Section 3-802 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-802) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-802)

7 Sec. 3-802. Reclassifications and upgrades.

8 (a) Definitions. For the purposes of this Section, the
9 following words shall have the meanings ascribed to them as
10 follows:

11 "Reclassification" means changing the registration of
12 a vehicle from one plate category to another.

13 "Upgrade" means increasing the registered weight of a
14 vehicle within the same plate category.

15 (b) When reclassing the registration of a vehicle from one
16 plate category to another, the owner shall receive credit for

1 the unused portion of the present plate and be charged the
2 current portion fees for the new plate. In addition, the
3 appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees
4 shall be assessed.

5 (b-5) Beginning with the 2018 registration year, any
6 individual who has a registration issued under either Section
7 3-405 or 3-405.1 that qualifies for a special license plate
8 under Sections 3-609, 3-609.1, 3-620, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625,
9 3-626, 3-638, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 3-676,
10 3-677, 3-680, 3-683, 3-686, or 3-693 may reclass his or her
11 registration upon acquiring a special license plate listed in
12 this subsection (b-5) without a replacement plate fee or
13 registration sticker cost.

14 (c) When upgrading the weight of a registration within the
15 same plate category, the owner shall pay the difference in
16 current period fees between the two plates. In addition, the
17 appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees
18 shall be assessed. In the event new plates are not required,
19 the corrected registration card fee shall be assessed.

20 (d) In the event the owner of the vehicle desires to change
21 the registered weight and change the plate category, the owner
22 shall receive credit for the unused portion of the registration
23 fee of the current plate and pay the current portion of the
24 registration fee for the new plate, and in addition, pay the
25 appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees.

26 (e) Reclassing from one plate category to another plate

1 category can be done only once within any registration period.

2 (f) No refunds shall be made in any of the circumstances
3 found in subsection (b), subsection (c), or subsection (d);
4 however, when reclassing from a flat weight plate to an
5 apportioned plate, a refund may be issued if the credit amounts
6 to an overpayment.

7 (g) In the event the registration of a vehicle registered
8 under the mileage tax option is revoked, the owner shall be
9 required to pay the annual registration fee in the new plate
10 category and shall not receive any credit for the mileage plate
11 fees.

12 (h) Certain special interest plates may be displayed on
13 first division vehicles, second division vehicles weighing
14 8,000 pounds or less, and recreational vehicles. Those plates
15 can be transferred within those vehicle groups.

16 (i) Plates displayed on second division vehicles weighing
17 8,000 pounds or less and passenger vehicle plates may be
18 reclassified from one division to the other.

19 (j) Other than in subsection (i), reclassing from one
20 division to the other division is prohibited. In addition, a
21 reclass from a motor vehicle to a trailer or a trailer to a
22 motor vehicle is prohibited.
