1 AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing

 Section 17-142.1 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/17-142.1) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 17-142.1)
- Sec. 17-142.1. To defray health insurance costs. To provide for the partial reimbursement of health insurance costs.
 - (1) On the first day of September of each year, beginning in 1988, the Board may, by separate warrant, pay to each recipient of a service retirement, disability retirement or survivor's pension an amount to be determined by the Board, which shall represent partial reimbursement for the cost of the recipient's health insurance coverage.
 - (2) In lieu of the annual payment authorized in subdivision (1), for pensioners enrolled in the Fund's regular health care deduction plans, the Fund may pay the health insurance premium reimbursement on a monthly rather than annual basis, at the percentage rate established from time to time by the Board. If the Board so directs, these monthly payments may be made in the form of a direct payment of premium and a reduction in the amount deducted from the annuity, rather than in the form of reimbursement by separate warrant.

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1	(3) Total payments under this Section in any year may not
2	exceed \$65,000,000 plus any amount that was authorized to be
3	paid under this Section in the preceding year but was not
4	actually paid by the Board, including any interest earned
5	thereon.
6	(4) The total amount of payments under this Section in any
7	year may not exceed 75% of the total cost of health insurance
8	coverage in that year for all the recipients who receive
9	payments authorized by this Section in that year.
10	(5) There is hereby created the Chicago Teachers' Pension
11	Fund Health Insurance Task Force. The Task Force shall consist
12	of 12 members appointed as follows:
13	(a) Eight members, 2 of whom shall be appointed by each
14	of the 4 legislative leaders.
15	(b) One member, who shall be appointed by the board of
16	trustees of the Fund.
17	(c) One member, who shall be appointed by an
18	organization that represents retired Chicago teachers.
19	(d) One member, who shall be appointed by an
20	organization that represents Chicago teachers.
21	(e) One member, who shall be appointed by the chairman
22	of the Chicago Board of Education.
23	The Task force shall study and consider the program of
24	health insurance coverage for pensioners that is currently

administered by the Fund, and shall present its findings and

recommendations concerning the following specified matters:

(i) the need for increasing the \$65,000,000 limitation
on annual payments under subsection (3) of this Section;
(ii) moving the administration of the retiree health
plan to another appropriate public or private entity;
(iii) suggestions for an exit strategy and transition;
(iv) consideration of alternative funding mechanisms;
<u>and</u>
(v) consideration of the proper role of fiduciaries in
administering the health insurance program.
Members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation.
The Fund shall provide a meeting place and clerical support for
the Task Force.
The Task Force shall present a final report of its findings
and recommendations to the Governor of Illinois, the Mayor of
Chicago, the Illinois General Assembly, and the Illinois State
Library no later than January 31, 2017. Upon the filing of its
report and the conclusion of its business, the Task Force is
abolished.
