SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.875 new
625 ILCS 5/3-699.15 new

Amends the State Finance Act. Creates the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund as a special fund in the State treasury. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of U.S. Coast Guard license plates. Provides that an applicant shall pay \$20 for the original issuance of the plate, in addition to any appropriate registration fees. Of this fee, \$5 shall be deposited into the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that for each registration renewal period, an applicant shall pay a \$20 fee in addition to any appropriate registration fees. Of this fee, \$18 shall be deposited into the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that money in the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund shall be paid as grants for charitable purposes and financial assistance programs sponsored by Coast Guard Mutual Assistance, Inc.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Section 5.875 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.875 new)

7 Sec. 5.875. The Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
9 Section 3-699.15 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.15 new)

11 Sec. 3-699.15. Coast Guard license plates.

12 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
13 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
14 State, may issue special registration plates designated as U.S.
15 Coast Guard plates. The special plates issued under this
16 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the
17 first division or motor vehicles of the second division
18 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates under this Section
19 shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established
20 by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

21 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be

1 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
2 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany
3 each application.

4 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for the
5 original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration
6 fee, if applicable. Of this fee, \$5 shall be deposited into the
7 Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund and \$15 shall be deposited
8 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. For
9 each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the
10 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this fee,
11 \$18 shall be deposited into the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance
12 Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State
13 Special License Plate Fund.

14 (d) The Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Fund is created as a
15 special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Coast
16 Guard Mutual Assistance Fund shall be paid, subject to
17 appropriation by the General Assembly and distribution by the
18 Secretary, as grants for charitable purposes and financial
19 assistance programs sponsored by Coast Guard Mutual
20 Assistance, Inc., a recognized charitable organization that
21 meets the requirements of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the
22 United States Code.
