1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6075

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6075 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 7-704 and 7-704.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/7-704)

7 Sec. 7-704. Suspension to continue until compliance with
8 court order of support.

9 (a) The suspension of a driver's license shall remain in
10 effect unless and until the Secretary of State receives
11 authenticated documentation that the obligor is in compliance
12 with a court order of support or that the order has been stayed
13 by a subsequent order of the court. Full driving privileges
14 shall not be issued by the Secretary of State until
15 notification of compliance has been received from the court.
16 The circuit clerks shall report the obligor's compliance with a

1 court order of support to the Secretary of State, on a form
2 prescribed by the Secretary.

3 (a-1) The suspension of a driver's license shall remain in
4 effect unless and until the Secretary of State receives
5 authenticated documentation as to the person who violated a
6 visitation order that the court has determined that there has
7 been sufficient compliance for a sufficient period of time with
8 the court's order concerning visitation and that full driving
9 privileges shall be reinstated or that the order has been
10 stayed by a subsequent order of the court. Full driving
11 privileges shall not be issued by the Secretary of State until
12 notification has been received from the court. The circuit
13 clerk shall report any court order in which the court
14 determined that there has been sufficient compliance for a
15 sufficient period of time with the court's order concerning
16 visitation and that full driving privileges shall be reinstated
17 to the Secretary of State on a form prescribed by the
18 Secretary.

19 (b) Whenever, after 2 suspensions ~~one suspension~~ of an
20 individual's driver's license for failure to pay child support,
21 another order of non-payment is entered against the obligor and
22 the person fails to come into compliance with the court order
23 of support, then the Secretary shall again suspend the driver's
24 license of the individual and that suspension shall not be
25 removed unless the obligor is in full compliance with the court
26 order of support and has made full payment on all arrearages.

1 (b-1) Whenever, after one suspension of an individual's
2 driver's license for failure to abide by a visitation order,
3 another order finding visitation abuse is entered against the
4 person and the court orders the suspension of the person's
5 driver's license, then the Secretary shall again suspend the
6 driver's license of the individual and that suspension shall
7 not be removed until the court has determined that there has
8 been sufficient compliance for a sufficient period of time with
9 the court's order concerning visitation and that full driving
10 privileges shall be reinstated.

11 (c) Section 7-704.1, and not this Section, governs the
12 duration of a driver's license suspension if the suspension
13 occurs as the result of a certification by the Illinois
14 Department of Healthcare and Family Services under subsection
15 (c) of Section 7-702.

18 Sec. 7-704.1. Duration of driver's license suspension upon
19 certification of Department of Healthcare and Family Services.

20 (a) When a suspension of a driver's license occurs as the
21 result of a certification by the Illinois Department of
22 Healthcare and Family Services under subsection (c) of Section
23 7-702, the suspension shall remain in effect until the
24 Secretary of State receives notification from the Department
25 that the person whose license was suspended has paid the

1 support delinquency in full or has arranged for payment of the
2 delinquency and current support obligation in a manner
3 satisfactory to the Department.

4 (b) Whenever, after 2 suspensions ~~one suspension~~ of an
5 individual's driver's license based on certification of the
6 Department of Healthcare and Family Services, another
7 certification is received from the Department of Healthcare and
8 Family Services, the Secretary shall again suspend the driver's
9 license of that individual and that suspension shall not be
10 removed unless the obligor is in full compliance with the order
11 of support and has made full payment on all arrearages.
