1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
2-3.163 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.163)

Sec. 2-3.163. Prioritization of Urgency of Need for
8 Services database.

9 (a) The General Assembly makes all of the following 10 findings:

(1) The Department of Human Services maintains a statewide database known as the Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services that records information about individuals with developmental disabilities who are potentially in need of services.

16 (2) The Department of Human Services uses the data on
 17 Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services to select
 18 individuals for services as funding becomes available, to
 19 develop proposals and materials for budgeting, and to plan
 20 for future needs.

(3) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services is
available for children and adults with a developmental
disability who have an unmet service need anticipated in

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1 the next 5 years.

(4) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services is
the first step toward getting developmental disabilities
services in this State. If individuals are not on the
Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services waiting
list, they are not in queue for State developmental
disabilities services.

8 (5) Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services may 9 be underutilized by children and their parents or guardians 10 due to lack of awareness or lack of information.

11 (b) The State Board of Education may work with school 12 districts to inform all students with developmental 13 disabilities and their parents or quardians about the 14 Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services database.

15 (c) Subject to appropriation, the Department of Human 16 Services and State Board of Education shall develop and 17 implement an online, computer-based training program for at least one designated employee in every public school in this 18 State to educate him or her about the Prioritization of Urgency 19 20 of Need for Services database and steps to be taken to ensure children and adolescents are enrolled. The training shall 21 22 include instruction for at least one designated employee in 23 public in contacting everv school the appropriate developmental disabilities Independent Service Coordination 24 25 agency to enroll children and adolescents in the database. At 26 least one designated employee in every public school shall

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ensure the opportunity to enroll in the Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services database is discussed during annual individualized education program (IEP) meetings for all children and adolescents believed to have a developmental disability.

6 (d) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the 7 Department of Human Services, shall inform parents and 8 guardians of students through school districts about the 9 Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services waiting list, 10 <u>including the consideration required in subsection (e) of this</u> 11 Section.

12 <u>(e) The Department of Human Services shall consider the</u> 13 <u>length of time spent on the Prioritization of Urgency of Need</u> 14 <u>for Services waiting list, in addition to other factors</u> 15 <u>considered, when selecting individuals on the list for</u> 16 <u>services.</u>
