- 5 Martial Arts Act.
- 6 Section 130. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Compassionate
- 8 Use of Medical Cannabis Fund to the Department of Financial
- 9 and Professional Regulation for all costs associated with
- 10 operational expenses of the department in relation to the
- 11 regulation of medical marijuana.
- 12 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 13 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 14 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
