Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 3 ARTICLE 2
- Section 1. The sum of \$1,243,749,650, or so much thereof
- 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State Employees'
- 7 Retirement System of Illinois for the State's contribution,
- 8 as provided by law.
- 9 Section 5. The sum of \$124,767,000, or so much thereof
- 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 11 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges Retirement System
- 12 of Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.
- 13 Section 10. The sum of \$20,635,000, or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 15 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly
- 16 Retirement System for the State's contribution, as provided
- 17 by law.
- 18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
- 19 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 20 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced

1 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
