The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of 4 Healthcare and Family Services from the Electronic Health 5 Record Incentive Fund for the purpose of payments to 6 qualifying health care providers to encourage the adoption 7 and use of certified electronic health records technology 8 pursuant to paragraph 1903 (t)(1) of the Social Security Act.

9 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 10 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General 11 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 12 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
