Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	ARTICLE 1
5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7	to the Human Rights Commission for the objects and purposes
8	hereinafter enumerated:
9	GENERAL OFFICE
10	Payable from General Revenue Fund:
11	For Personal Services
12	For State Contributions to Social Security123,700
13	For Contractual Services120,800
14	For Travel6,100
15	For Commodities6,500
16	For Printing
17	For Equipment
18	For Electronic Data Processing
19	For Telecommunications Services
20	Total \$1,928,400

Section 5. The sum of \$293,300, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 2 Fund to the Human Rights Commission for the Illinois Torture
- 3 Inquiry Relief Commission.
- 4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
- 5 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 6 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- 7 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
