The amount of \$23,010,400, or so much 14 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 15 Homeland Security Emergency Preparedness Trust Fund to the 16 Illinois Emergency Management Agency for current and prior 17 year expenses related to the federally funded Emergency 18 Preparedness Grant Program.

Section 25. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses

1 Section 60. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 3 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency licensing facilities where radioactive uranium for 4 and thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related 5 6 costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning of such facilities and for identification, decontamination 7 environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties 8 and 9 contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings.

10 Section 65. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund 12 to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the purpose 13 of funding costs related to environmental cleanup of the 14 Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under cooperative 15 agreements with the Federal Government.

16 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 17 is appropriated from the Radiation may be necessary, 18 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 19 for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 20 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses 21 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 22 surety.

1 Section 75. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection 3 Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for local 4 responder training, demonstrations, research, studies and 5 investigations under funding agreements with the Federal 6 Government.

7 Section 80. The sum of \$35,000, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 9 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 10 Management Agency for related training and travel expenses and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 11 12 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 13 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste 14 in 15 Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency.

Section 85. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield February 18 1982 Agreed Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management 19 Agency for the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, 20 remediation and insurance of the low-level radioactive waste 21 disposal site near Sheffield, Illinois.

22 Section 90. The sum of \$650,000, or so much thereof as

1 be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level mav Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 2 Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 3 the use in accordance with Section 14(a) of the 4 Illinois Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related 5 to 6 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.

Section 95. The sum of \$240,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to include support of a centralized administrative processing center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 14 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General 15 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 16 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
