SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, as follows:

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AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

22 Section 60. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as 23 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue HB6406 -7- OMB099 00231 AXW 20231 b 1 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority 2 for the purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of 3 the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

Section 65. The amount of \$525,000, or so much thereof
as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
Program.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 10 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General 11 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 12 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
