A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the
6 Department of Public Health for expenses of programs related
7 to Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and Human
8 Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV):

9 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROTECTION: AIDS/HIV

10 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

11 For Expenses of AIDS/HIV Education,
12 Drugs, Services, Counseling, Testing,
13 Outreach to Minority populations, costs
14 associated with correctional facilities
15 Referral and Partner Notification
16 (CTRPN), and Patient and Worker
17 Notification pursuant to Public
18 Act 87-76326,000,000

19 Payable from the Public Health Services Fund:

20 For Expenses of Programs for Prevention
21 of AIDS/HIV6,250,000
22 For Expenses for Surveillance Programs and
23 Seroprevalence Studies of AIDS/HIV1,750,000

1 For Expenses Associated with the
 2 Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS
 3 Resource Emergency Act of
 4 1990 (CARE) and other AIDS/HIV services55,000,000
 5 Total \$63,000,000

6 Payable from the African-American
 7 HIV/AIDS Response Fund:
 8 For grants and other expenses for
 9 the prevention and treatment of
 10 HIV/AIDS and the creation of an HIV/AIDS
 11 service delivery system to reduce the
 12 disparity of HIV infection and AIDS cases
 13 between African-Americans and other
 14 population groups1,500,000

15 Payable from the Quality of Life Endowment Fund:
 16 For grants and expenses associated
 17 with HIV/AIDS prevention2,400,000

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
 19 2016.
