### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State Appellate Defender. Makes further appropriations for: expenses related to federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases; expenses related to providing public defenders in rural counties the resources needed to adequately investigate and defend indigent clients; the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program; statewide training to Public Defenders; and developing a Juvenile Defender Resource Center. Effective July 1, 2016.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services .....	\$16,277,738
10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	\$1,204,553
11	For Contractual Services .....	\$2,204,000
12	For Travel .....	\$55,000
13	For Commodities .....	\$43,000
14	For Printing .....	\$44,000
15	For Equipment .....	\$45,000
16	For EDP .....	\$874,000
17	For Telecommunications .....	\$125,000
18	For Law Student Program .....	<u>\$65,000</u>
19	Total .....	\$20,937,291

20 Section 10. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Appellate  
22 Defender Federal Trust Fund to the Office of the State

1 Appellate Defender for expenses related to federally assisted  
2 programs to work on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases  
3 to which the agency is appointed and provide public defenders  
4 in rural counties the resources needed to adequately  
5 investigate and defend indigent clients.

6 Section 15. The amount of \$75,000, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for  
9 expenses related to providing public defenders in rural  
10 counties the resources needed to adequately investigate and  
11 defend indigent clients.

12 Section 20. The amount of \$160,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the  
15 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

16 Section 25. The amount \$63,000, or so much thereof as may  
17 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
18 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide  
19 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public  
20 Defender Training Program.

21 Section 30. The amount of \$320,000, or so much thereof as

1     may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund  
2     to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a  
3     Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

4             Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
5     2016.
