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HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Executive Order 1997-01 created the Governor's 3 Commission on the Status of Women, which was directed to 4 identify solutions to remove obstacles and impediments that 5 face women and families in Illinois; and

6 WHEREAS, The majority of the obstacles and impediments that 7 were identified by the Governor's Commission on the Status of 8 Women in 1998 remain unresolved; and

9 WHEREAS, In a continuing effort to help women achieve 10 economic independence, the General Assembly finds that it is 11 necessary to reestablish the Commission on the Status of Women 12 in order to continue this important work; therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, ΒY HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES THE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE 14 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the Commission 15 on the Status of Women within the Office of the Governor in 16 order to identify solutions to remove obstacles and impediments 17 18 in education, employment, business, and health care in Illinois; and be it further 19

20 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall consist of the 21 following members: HJ0084 -2- LRB099 12643 GRL 36438 r (1) two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

3 (2) two members of the House of Representatives
4 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of
5 Representatives;

6 (3) two members of the Senate appointed by the 7 President of the Senate;

8 (4) two members of the Senate appointed by the Minority
9 Leader of the Senate;

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(5) one member appointed by the Governor; and

(6) eight members of the public, two each appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate, and the Minority Leader of the Senate; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That vacancies occurring because of death or 17 resignation shall be filled by the appointing authority for the 18 group in which the vacancy occurs; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall, within 30 days after 20 all of the members have been appointed, organize by appointing 21 one member as its Chairperson and by making necessary rules for 22 the administration of the Commission that are not inconsistent 23 with this resolution; and be it further HJ0084 -3- LRB099 12643 GRL 36438 r RESOLVED, That the Commission may employ those employees and assistants as it deems necessary without regard to the Personnel Code or any other law of this State concerning State employment; the members of the Commission and their employees and assistants shall serve without compensation; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That 9 members of the Commission shall constitute 8 a quorum for the transaction of business, and the concurrence 9 of at least 8 Commissioners shall be necessary to render a 10 decision by the Commission; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall undertake the 12 following activities:

(1) studying the status of women in this State and make recommendations for constructive action in employment policies and practices, Illinois labor laws, legal rights, the family and the employed woman, women and citizens volunteers, access to health care, education, and expanded health care and employment programs to help women as wives, mothers, and workers;

20 (2) studying and analyzing all facts relating to 21 Illinois laws, regulations, and guidelines with respect to 22 equal protection under the Illinois Constitution; and

(3) surveying activity in the area of the status of
 women carried on by any commission, agency, or department

4 RESOLVED, That the Commission may accept monetary gifts or 5 grants from the federal government or its agencies, from any charitable foundation or professional association, or from any 6 7 other reputable source for the implementation of any program 8 necessary or desirable for carrying out the general purposes of 9 the Commission; such gifts and grants may be held in trust by 10 the Commission and expended in the exercise of its powers and 11 performance of its duties and prescribed by law; and be it 12 further

13 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall make a full report of 14 its proceedings, recommendations concerning the activities of 15 the Commission, and recommendations for legislative 16 consideration and action to the Governor and the members of the 17 General Assembly on or before February 1, 2016.
