## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois General Assembly are 3 proud to pay tribute to those who have given their lives to 4 protect and serve the citizens of this State; and

5 WHEREAS, Twenty-seven year old Illinois State Trooper John 6 Kugelman was a 3-year veteran of the Illinois State Police; a 7 former military police officer, he was on the waiting list to 8 become a Chicago police officer when he was hired by the 9 Illinois State Police and assigned to District 2 in Elgin; and

10 WHEREAS, On November 10, 1986, Trooper John Kugelman was 11 manning a roadblock in order to subdue a parole violator who 12 led police on an 85 MPH chase; leaving his squad car, he 13 attempted to halt the suspect's car while on foot when he was 14 struck and killed by the suspect; and

15 WHEREAS, After his tragic passing, Trooper John Kugelman 16 was posthumously promoted to the rank of Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, Trooper John Kugelman was survived by his wife, Janice; his parents; his sister, Beth; and his nephew; therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 15 delivered to the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority, the 16 Illinois Department of Transportation, and the family of 17 Trooper John Kugelman.
