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1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Many government agencies and universities have experience with the difficulty of the procurement process in the State; and

  WHEREAS, There is a high administrative cost to procurement; and
- WHEREAS, Added compliance costs limit competition and increase the prices that the State must pay; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Reverse auctions are done publicly online, 10 increasing transparency and reducing bureaucracy; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Reverse auctions may serve to increase 12 competition, lower price, and reduce paperwork; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Reverse auction processes have been implemented 14 in other states, including Florida and Texas, and should be 15 studied for use in Illinois; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
  NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE
  SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Task Force on Reverse
  Auction Procurement be created to:

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- 1 (1) thoroughly examine the reverse auction procurement 2 process to determine whether such a system should be 3 implemented in Illinois, including, but not limited to,
- 5 whether it has been successful there:
  - (2) recommend amendments to the Procurement Code to implement a reverse auction procurement process if the Task Force decides that it would be beneficial in this State;

examining how other states have implemented the system and

- (3) produce a final report summarizing the Task Force's findings and detailing recommended statutory changes, if necessary; and be it further

  - (1) two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one of which shall be a member of the House and the other which shall not;
  - (2) two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, one of which shall be a member of the House and the other which shall not;
  - (3) two members appointed by the President of the Senate, one of which shall be a member of the Senate and the other which shall not;
  - (4) two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one of which shall be a member of the Senate and the other which shall not; and
