SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IX, Sec. 11 new

Proposes to amend the Revenue Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that an additional income tax shall be imposed on individuals in an amount equal to 3% of the portion of the individual's income that is greater than \$1,000,000 for the taxable year. Provides that the revenue collected from the tax shall be distributed to school districts on a per pupil basis. Effective upon being declared adopted.

3 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
 4 NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE
 5 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the
 6 electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general
 7 election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of
 8 this resolution a proposition to add Section 11 to Article IX
 9 of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

10 ARTICLE IX
 11 REVENUE

12 (ILCON Art. IX, Sec. 11 new)

13 SECTION 11. TAX FOR EDUCATION

14 Notwithstanding subsection (a) of Section 3 of this
 15 Article, and in addition to any other tax, a tax shall be
 16 imposed on individuals in an amount equal to 3% of income
 17 greater than \$1,000,000 for the taxable year. All revenue
 18 collected pursuant to this Section shall be distributed to
 19 school districts solely on a per pupil basis. The General
 20 Assembly by law shall provide for the implementation and
 21 enforcement of this Section.

22 SCHEDULE

1 This Constitutional Amendment takes effect upon being
2 declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois
3 Constitutional Amendment Act and applies to taxable years
4 beginning on or after January 1, 2017.
