SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 6

Proposes to amend a portion of the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution that concerns the organization of the General Assembly. Deletes a provision which provides that a member of the General Assembly may be expelled from office only once for the same offense. Effective upon being declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois Constitutional Amendment Act.

3	RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4	NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE
5	SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the
6	electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general
7	election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of
8	this resolution a proposition to amend Section 6 of Article IV
9	of the Illinois Constitution as follows:
10	ARTICLE IV
11	THE LEGISLATURE
12	(ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 6)
13	SECTION 6. ORGANIZATION
14	(a) A majority of the members elected to each house
15	constitutes a quorum.
16	(b) On the first day of the January session of the General
17	Assembly in odd-numbered years, the Secretary of State shall
18	convene the House of Representatives to elect from its
19	membership a Speaker of the House of Representatives as

23 (c) For purposes of powers of appointment conferred by this

presiding officer, and the Governor shall convene the Senate to

elect from its membership a President of the Senate as

- 1 Constitution, the Minority Leader of either house is a member
- 2 of the numerically strongest political party other than the
- 3 party to which the Speaker or the President belongs, as the
- 4 case may be.
- 5 (d) Each house shall determine the rules of its
- 6 proceedings, judge the elections, returns and qualifications
- 7 of its members and choose its officers. No member shall be
- 8 expelled by either house, except by a vote of two-thirds of the
- 9 members elected to that house. A member may be expelled only
- 10 once for the same offense. Each house may punish by
- imprisonment any person, not a member, guilty of disrespect to
- 12 the house by disorderly or contemptuous behavior in its
- 13 presence. Imprisonment shall not extend beyond twenty-four
- hours at one time unless the person persists in disorderly or
- 15 contemptuous behavior.
