1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Someone develops Alzheimer's disease every 67 seconds; and

- WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is on the rise with 5.4 million Americans currently living with the disease and an estimated 16 million Americans projected to be diagnosed with the disease by 2050; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Currently, 210,000 people in Illinois live with 9 the disease; there will be 260,000 in 10 years; and
- WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the 6th leading cause of 10 11 death and an unrelenting, progressive condition that destroys 12 brain cells, and currently no cure or even a way to slow the 13 of the disease exists; Alzheimer's places progression significant financial burdens on families and businesses, with 14 businesses losing billions a year in lost productivity and 15 16 replacement expenses for employees who miss work or quit to care for a relative; and 17
  - WHEREAS, In Illinois in 2013, there were 587,000 Illinois family members and friends who provided over 668 million hours of unpaid care, valued at \$8.3 billion, to their loved ones with Alzheimer's and other dementias; and

  - WHEREAS, On March 11, 2015, Alzheimer's advocates will speak up for the needs and rights of people with Alzheimer's and their families and ask the Illinois legislature to make Alzheimer's disease a priority public health issue in the State of Illinois; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we proclaim March 11, 2015 as the Annual Alzheimer's Association Advocacy Day in the State of Illinois.
