17 WHEREAS, The non-profit arts sector is an economic engine 18 and plays a significant role in the economic health of 19 communities large and small with direct expenditures of wages 20 and benefits and in goods and services; and

9 WHEREAS, Studies have found that 8th graders from 10 under-resourced environments who are highly involved in the 11 arts have better grades, less likelihood of dropping out by 12 grade 10, have more positive attitudes about school, and are 13 more likely to go to college; and

14 WHEREAS, Attracting and retaining the best teachers is 15 vital and can be achieved by ensuring that schools embrace the 16 arts, becoming havens for creativity and innovation; and

17 WHEREAS, Arts education has the power to make students want 18 to learn not just within the arts, but other areas of study; therefore, be it 19
