1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Veterans have sacrificed their livelihoods and 3 oftentimes their careers to defend our nation's freedom; and

WHEREAS, According to the United States Department of
Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics, among the 573,000
unemployed veterans nationwide in 2014, 59% were ages 45 and
over, 37% were ages 25 to 44, and 4% were ages 18 to 24; and

8 WHEREAS, In 2014, the unemployment rate of veterans varied 9 by state, ranging from 1.4% in North Dakota to 8.5% in 10 Maryland; Illinois has one of the highest veteran unemployment 11 rates in the nation; and

12 WHEREAS, According to a Bureau of Labor Statistics report 13 released on March 18, 2015, Illinois has the 8th highest 14 unemployment rate of veterans in the United States; and

15 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois should be a leader at 16 providing all the resources necessary to help unemployed 17 veterans get back to work; and
