- WHEREAS, If the disease goes undetected, retinoblastoma requires the removal of the eye to keep the disease from spreading to the optic nerve and the brain; and

 - WHEREAS, The members of this body believe that greater attention must be placed on raising awareness of retinoblastoma and other cancers in order to fight these debilitating diseases and the effects they have on the citizens of this State; therefore, be it
