18 WHEREAS, Larry Lubertozzi was active in his community, a
19 longtime supporter and past president of the Tall Grass Arts

2 also an active member of the Sauk-Calumet Chapter of the Sierra
3 Club and the Thorn Creek Audubon Society; and

4 WHEREAS, Larry Lubertozi volunteered in many local,
5 State, and national elections and served as treasurer for State
6 Representative Jim Marzuki's successful campaign; and

7 WHEREAS, Larry Lubertozi is survived by his loving wife;
8 his sons; his daughter-in-law; his grandson; his brother, Carl;
9 his sister, Marie Martin; and his many extended family members,
10 which include many brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, nieces,
