13 WHEREAS, Max Chapman, born October 17, 2013 and a resident 14 of Bloomington, was diagnosed with PBD at the age of 14 months; 15 with his loving heart, his cheerful disposition, and boundless 16 personality he has inspired countless family members and 17 friends in Central Illinois to spread awareness of this 18 devastating disorder; and
