6 home on the northwest side of Chicago to Ferdinand and Dorothy
7 Havlik; he married Mildred Eileen Moe on May 19, 1951; and

8 WHEREAS, Robert Havlik attended Farnsworth Elementary
9 School; after their father passed away when Robert was nine, he
10 and his brother, Ferdinand Jr. "Fred", took a paper route to
11 help their mother; he went on to attend Lane Technical High
12 School; he graduated in 1942; and

13 WHEREAS, Robert Havlik worked at Western Electric as a
14 millwright until he enlisted in the United States Navy on March
15 12, 1943; after attending basic training at the Great Lakes
16 Naval Training base, he served in Norfolk, Virginia and aboard
17 the USS Bull; after his discharge in 1945, he returned to
18 Western Electric to work as a millwright for the next 44 years
19 and one month until the company closed; and

20 WHEREAS, On June 8, 2016, Robert Havlik flew with the Honor
21 Flight from Chicago to Washington D.C., which he considers one

1 of his greatest memories; and

2 WHEREAS, Robert Havlik is the stepfather of Wayne Russell;
3 the father of Patricia Ann; the grandfather of Rene Lynn
4 Corbett and Aaron Daniel Jagelski; and the great-grandfather of
5 Michael Wayne Corbett; therefore, be it
